HORUS SCOPE SERIES 3

Peripheral devices support accurate diagnosis and treatment for the patient/client/resident. The Horus Scope 3 is a digital, hand-held camera used for transmitting live images of the body. It has three interchangeable lens attachments (otoscope, dermatoscope, and general imaging) to allow for multi-discipline medical applications during a telehealth video call.



- Ensure the battery is installed with the plus (+) tip towards the top of the device.
- The battery cover is located on the back, bottom portion of the device and can be removed by lifting up on the cover.

Charging

- Before first use place the Horus Scope on the charging station or connect the adapter via a USB cable and let charge for five hours.
- Ensure device is adequately charged prior to appointment (solid blue light on power • indicator while device is on).

Operating Time

Operating time for a fully charged Horus Scope is three hours. •

To Use

Attach the Lens

- Ensure power is off and the device has been removed from charger.
- Find and match the lens alignment marks (black circles) on the Horus Scope and lens.
- Insert the lens into the Horus Scope and rotate gently (clockwise).
- Ensure the position bars (white lines) are in the appropriate horizontal position.
- To change the lens: press the button next to the lens to release the lens, turn counterclockwise to remove.

Note: Horus Scope will display an image **only** when a lens is attached.

Connect AV-out (Mini USB) Cord to telehealth unit

Depending on the type of telehealth unit you are using, to view and share images during the appointment, connect the AV-out (Mini USB) cord as follows:

- When used with Avizia cart, connect directly to the AV (in)/composite port in drawer of cart
- When used with DX80, or Cisco SX20, connect the mini USB cord directly to the telehealth unit

<u>Note:</u> Other telehealth units may require an additional cable to connect the telehealth unit to a converter. Please check with your telehealth technical lead to confirm.

Turn on the Horus Scope

- The power button is located at the top.
- NOTE: camera will not display image unless a lens is attached.
- NOTE: images/videos are not recorded or saved during live Telehealth appointments. however once a clear image is
 achieved on the screen, it can be "frozen" on the screen by pressing the center "Ok" button.

Adjust Brightness / Focus

- Use the brightness controls located on the front (under the 'OK' button) to adjust the amount of light produced by the Horus Scope, ranging from 0-10.
- These buttons can also be used to zoom in/out on an image.
- Use the focus wheel (found on the back) to adjust image quality.









- Click the Share option on your telehealth unit to share the image with the virtual provider .
- Once a clear image is displayed on your cameras LCD screen, click OK to freeze the image. Allow a few seconds for the image to display.

Menu Screen

- 'Menu' button takes you to menu mode.
- Vertical arrows will cycle you through menu options.
- Use the horizontal arrows to select the menu items and press 'OK' to confirm selection.
- Press the 'Menu' button to return to live image mode.
- NOTE: if the 'Menu' button is pressed while in 'Display Picture' mode, the option to delete the selected image will appear. Press 'Camera/Video' button to return to 'Live Image' mode.
- The 'Menu' screen will return to 'Live Image' mode in 15 seconds if no button is pressed.

After Use

Cleaning

- Power off the Horus Scope for cleaning.
- Clean the lens with a dust free cleaning cloth, otherwise do not touch the lens.
- Disinfect the device with an alcohol wipe. Do not sterilize the device.
- Wait until cleaning solution is evaporated before using Horus Scope.

Recharging (procedure may vary by site)

- Place the Horus Scope in the charging station and connect the mini USB cable to the charging station (see picture to right);
 <u>or</u>
- Use USB charger to connect to a power adaptor or directly to the Avizia cart for charging (see picture below).





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
