


Provider Joining a Video Visit from CorCare (MyChart)


- 1) Locate your appointment list from the schedule (your schedule may look slightly different than this):



The screenshot shows the MyChart 'Schedule' page for a Family Medicine physician. The appointment list is as follows:



- 2) If you want to jump *directly* into your video meeting, Double Click the camera **icon**
 - Note: This will bring you into the “This Visit” navigator in CorCare, **as well as** launch the video visit session in your web browser!
- 3) If you would prefer to review the patient information prior to starting the video visit, double click anywhere else on the appointment row, to bring you into “This Visit” Navigator:



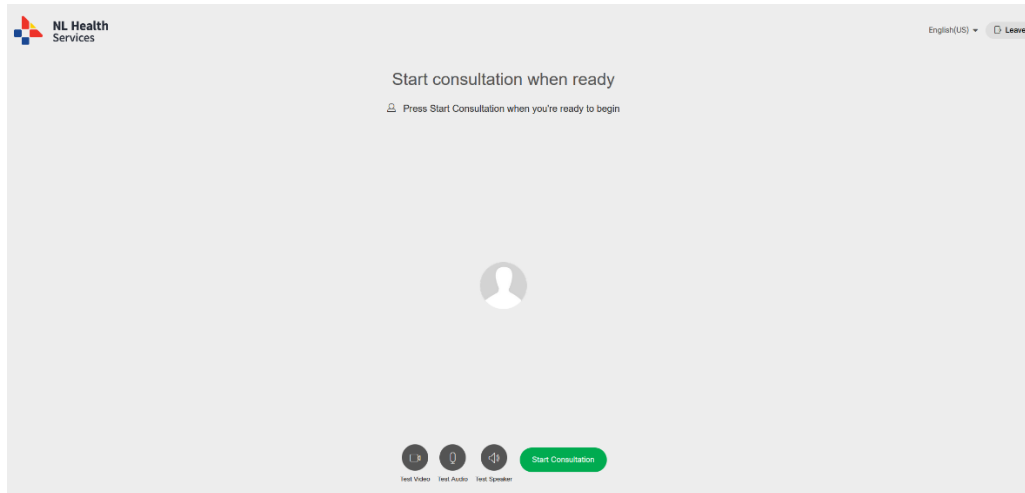

- 4) When you are ready to connect to the video meeting, click “**Connect to Video**” tab, then click **Connect to Video** button

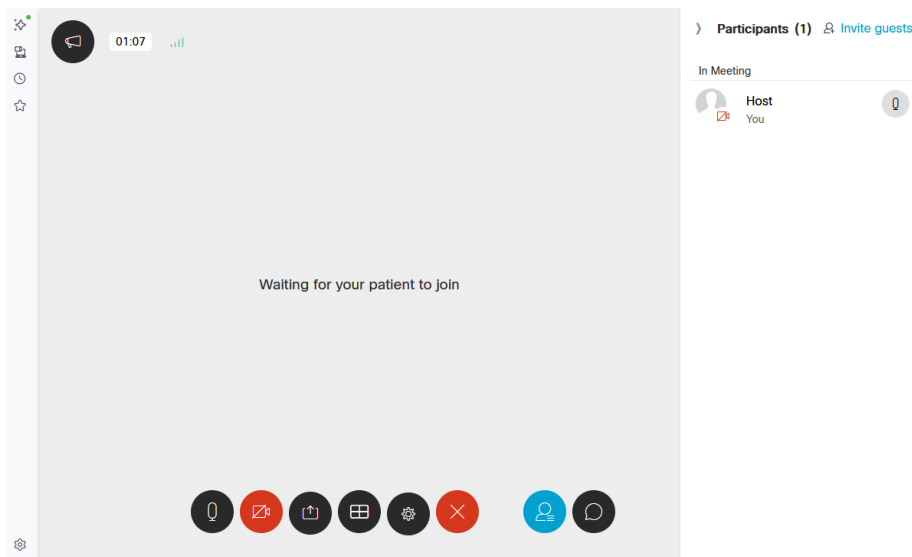

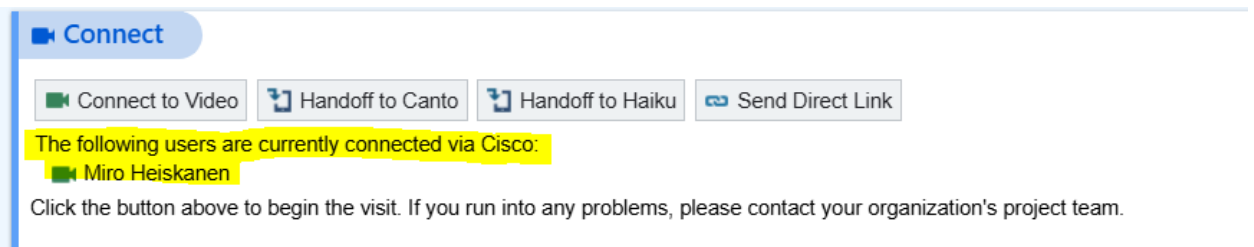
- 5) You may get prompted by your browser to allow access to Camera and Microphone (allow access)



- 6) Start your consultation. If the patient is already waiting in the virtual lobby, they will get brought into the room automatically after you begin.



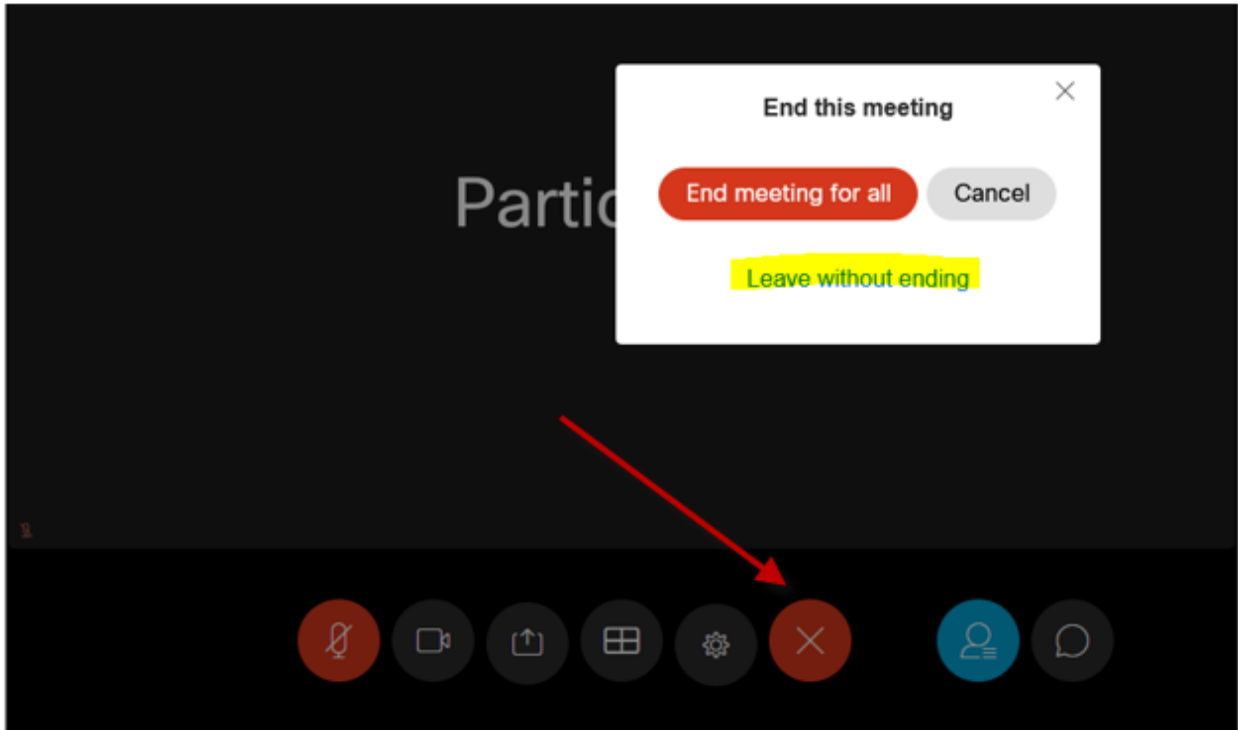
PRO TIP: If the patient has *already* connected to the video session and is waiting for you, CorCare will show it here:



7) Handing off to Haiku or Canto, and Ending the session

If you need to leave your desk mid-session, and wish to continue your video session via Haiku or Canto mobile apps you may do so:

- Click the red **X** circle to bring up the **End this meeting** dialogue box
- Select **LEAVE WITHOUT ENDING**



- You can rejoin your consultation from Haiku or Canto
- If you have completed the video session, simply click **End Meeting for All**
